Red Card (Send off) Procedures

Officials: If you need to report a **send off (red card)** that was given in, a *State Premier Division* match, [click here](#). Fill out the web-based form, hit, submit and a **pdf** of the send off report will be emailed to you with additional instructions. Please do this within **24 HOURS** of the match. You should contact the referee assignor in the League that the send off was given and report the incident.

The second file is for the sent off player or team official.

CYSA Cal Soccer League *Bay and Coast Divisions*

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North and Metro Divisions

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The procedures outlined below apply *only* to red cards/ send offs received in CYSA Cal Soccer League North and Metro Divisions

CCSL *North and Metro Divisions* PAD procedures will at all times be in compliance with those procedures outlined in the CCSL/Metro league Rules of Play, District VI Policy and Procedures, and the California Youth Soccer Association Protest and Appeals Manual.

Any and all game send off (red card) reports **must be submitted to the CCSL North and Metro Divisions PAD Chair and must be mailed *within 24 hours* of the issuance of the red card.**

Procedures for conduct of all CCSL *North and Metro Divisions* PAD meetings are found in the General Rules of District VI Metro League, Rule 3:05, ***Protests, Appeals and Disciplinary (PAD) Committee Hearing Procedures***, and Rule 3:06, ***Appeal Policies and Hearing Procedures***. Under these rules, the following will be adhered to: *the PAD Chair must receive 24 Hour Send Off Reports no later than Tuesday of the week following the game in which the red card was issued.*

During the League season, PAD Committee meetings will normally be held on Thursdays as necessary at a location determined by the PAD Chair.

Video tapes will *not* be allowed or reviewed and witnesses will *not* be called for interviews at these weekly PAD meetings. However, ***written statements from coaches, players, and league officials and, in some instances, observers will be reviewed by the PAD Committee*** during the PAD Committee hearing process.

Decisions of the PAD Committee will be sent in writing to your league representative as well as District officials. ***You must contact your CCSL/METRO League representative*** for the PAD decision and any other appropriate follow up.

Appeals from disciplinary decisions made by CCSL / Metro PAD Committee, shall be made to CYSA's Protest and Appeals Committee pursuant to the appeal procedures set forth in the CYSA Constitution and Bylaws, Procedures, Rules and PIMs, section 3:09. CYSA's Constitution and Bylaws, Procedures, Rules and PIMs are contained in CYSA's Team Manual. The making of an appeal does not stay or in any other manner, delay the discipline imposed in the decision being appealed.
